State Councils Summary:

- 1. 12 State Councils Responded so far.
- 2. 10 States identified Brook Trout as their #1 Priority
- 3. Illinois identified Lake Trout as #1
- 4. Maine Identified Atlantic Salmon as #1
- 5. Brook Trout were also listed in Illinois and Maine
- 6. Lake Trout were also identified in Michigan and Ohio
- 7. Overall Brook Trout is the priority species.

Many states have active restoration projects.

New Jersey claims to be a leader in Brook Trout restoration within the EBTJV.

Needs:

- 1. In general, more awareness on native trout issues.
 - 1. Signage
 - 2. Posters
 - 3. Trout In the Classroom
- 2. More science is needed to define distinct species.
- 3. Funding is needed for easements(?), riparian repair, culvert removal, etc. (Note that TU supports other organizations, such as land trusts, purchase of easements. TU, however, has a policy to not own such easements.)
- 4. Keep non-native species (Brown Trout) out of native trout habitat.
- 5. More emphasis (advocacy) on Lake Trout in Lake Michigan.
- 6. Advocacy for Arctic Char in Maine (Potential Endangered Species Listing).
- 7. In general, more advocacy for Brook Trout in Maine.
- 8. Identify large scale threats to native trout... water withdrawals, dams, culverts, invasive species, climate change.
