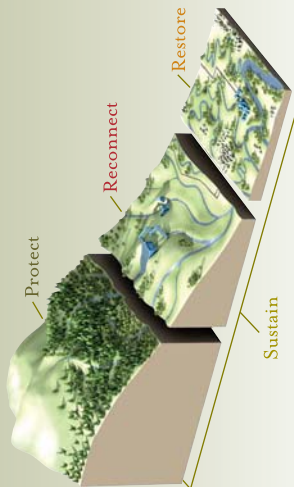

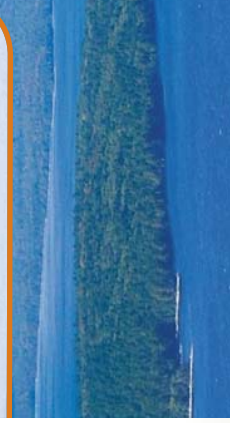
Watershed Words

Watershed: a region of land where all the water drains off into the same place, usually a large lake or ocean

Filter: a natural or human-made system that cleans water

Headwaters: clean, clear water at the highest point of a watershed

Tributary: stream or creek that flows into a larger river
