Call to Order 8PM ET

1. Welcome- (Rich Thomas)

Rich Thomas called the meeting to order on 8-06-2024, at 8pm ED, giving a special welcome to Chris Wood and Beverly Smith. Rich stated that after the Town Hall presentation, at approximately 8:30, there would be a National Leadership Council meeting, and that only representatives may vote although all are welcome to attend.

2. Re-Imagining TU's Membership Model (Chris Wood)

Chris Wood spoke as to what our new membership model could look like. He explained the tremendous growth TU has experienced and how our membership model must adapt. Chris believes that the second part of our strategic plan, to inspire people and communities across the country, will be met by sharing our beliefs with those who believe the same, and that they will become members. He stated that Millennials like to do things, and we need to capture their info when at our events. Gen Z likes nonprofits, so TU will market to their needs. The Boomers are a very philanthropic group. The goal is to inspire people through advocacy, volunteerism, and donations. TU has devised a strategy to collect this data and market to each group and each individual in each group. TU will utilize auto renewal for membership and move away from automatically giving gifts to sign up. We will wean off direct mail marketing and become more efficient and goal oriented.

Vol Opps Update (Beverly Smith)

Beverly Smith discussed the most recent Annual Activity Report. We had 630,931 volunteer hours, and chapters/councils raised \$16,170,160 of which grants were the largest contributor. Over half of the council/chapter expenditures are on conservation/science. There has been a steady shift away from meetings to events which is a positive occurrence, and in all measures, the grassroots model is working.
